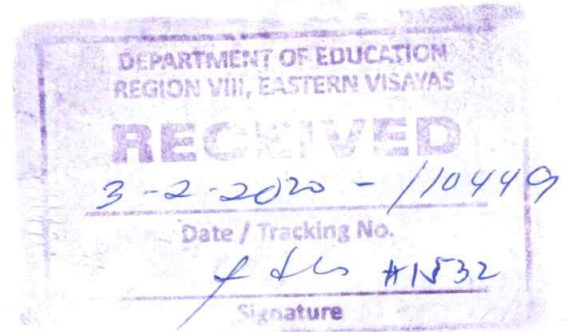

Greetings of peace and joy in the name of the Lord!



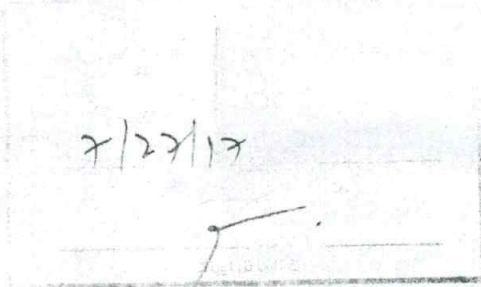
Dear Mr. Diaz:
