**REGIONAL SCREENING OF SELECTED REGION VIII SCHOLARS FOR THE 2020 KOREA-PHILIPPINES TEACHER EXCHANGE PROGRAM (KPTEP)**

To: Schools Division Superintendents  
 All Others Concerned

1. This Office, through the Human Resource Development Division (HRDD), will conduct the Regional Screening of Selected Region VIII Scholars for the 2020 Korea-Philippines Teacher Exchange Program (KPTEP) on February 11-12, 2020 at the Training Hall 1, NEAP R-8, DepEd Compound, Government Center, Candahug, Palo, Leyte.
2. The activity aims to screen teacher-scholars for recommendation to the National Level Screening of KPTEP nominees.
3. The teacher-scholar must possess the following qualifications:
  - a. Should have at least with 5 years teaching experience and with at least very satisfactory performance rating;
  - b. Preferably a Master Teacher;
  - c. Have not previously received any funding for longer than a month program from Korean Government;
  - d. English language proficient and preferably have basic knowledge in Korean language;
  - e. Should not be more than 50 years old and physically and mentally fit; and
  - f. With valid passport.
4. The teacher-scholars shall undergo Teacher's Portfolio Evaluation, Behavioral Events Interview (BEI) and Demonstration Teaching. The portfolio must contain the following documents:
  - a. Educational attainment;
  - b. Innovations and implemented programs in the school/ division/ region/ national;
  - c. Meritorious achievement;
  - d. Community and extension services; and
  - e. Endorsement of the School Head duly approved by the Superintendent



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5. The Schools Division Superintendents shall recommend two (2) teacher-scholars from the attached Regional Pool using the template. The recommendation letter must be submitted **on or before February 7, 2020** to Dr. Harvie D. Villamor, HRDD Chief through [hrdd.region8@deped.gov.ph](mailto:hrdd.region8@deped.gov.ph).
6. The two (2) teacher-scholars from each School Division Office (SDO) with the Regional Screening Committee shall report on February 10-12, 2020 at the Training Hall 1, NEAP R-8, DepEd Compound, Government Center, Candahug, Palo, Leyte. The first meal to be served shall be Dinner of February 10, 2020 and the last meal shall be PM snacks of February 12, 2020.
7. The board and lodging of the participants shall be charged to the RO Funds while the travel and incidental expenses shall be charged to the local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
