Terms of Reference and Do's and Don'ts for Participation to the 2020 National Festival of Talents (NFOT)

Terms of Reference

To ensure that each delegate shall be guided accordingly, every committee is advised to act on the following duties and functions; to wit:

Head of the Delegation/Over-All Chairperson

- Shall lead the delegation especially in making decisions relative to the region's participation
- Shall ensure the safety of each participant

Ass't. Head of the Delegation/Co-Chairperson

- Shall assist the Over-All Chairperson and decide for the former in his absence, if authorized

Regional Focal/s

- Shall ensure that all participants are well accommodated
- Shall take the responsibility in contacting the host region for whatever issues and concerns which may arise during the conduct of the activity
- Shall see to it that duties and functions of each committee chairs shall be implemented

Coach/Coaches

- Shall take care of all the contestants under his/her assigned contest category
- Shall observe time on task with her/his contestant/s. They must be at the contest venue one hour before the scheduled contest
- Shall ensure the safety of his or her contestant/s before, during, and after the conduct of the 2020 NFOT closing ceremony.
- Shall ensure that all his/her contestants are well-guided, protected and safe during travel and within the whole duration of the conduct of the 2020 NFOT
- Shall ensure that all necessary documents and materials to be used in the contest assigned to each contestant are well-prepared
- Shall have a contact number of the in-charge of the billeting school, Division EPS/Coordinator, Regional Focal, and contestant/s

Division EPSs/Contest Coordinator

- Shall assist the coach/coaches and the regional delegates in the preparation, during, and after the conduct of the activity
- Shall record best practices observed during the conduct of the activity
- Shall have the hotline numbers of the host region/division

Do's and Don'ts

The following are the safety measures to be observed by each participant:

1. Coaches together with their contestants shall observe **BUDDY SYSTEM** (e.g. company of 2 or more than two).
2. Log book shall be assigned by each delegate as locator of his/her whereabouts.
3. No coach/Adviser shall be allowed to go out on his own without official permission from the delegation Chairperson or co-chair.
4. Coach and contestant/s shall not separate from each other when going to the contest area and going home to the billeting quarter.
5. Cleanliness and orderliness shall be observed within the billeting area.
6. Utmost **DISCIPLINE** and **SILENCE** shall be observed during meal time, bedtime and practice time.
7. Priority services shall be given to the contestants with earlier scheduled official activities.
8. All participants shall attend the opening and closing ceremonies.

NOTE: ONLY THE OFFICIAL REGIONAL DELEGATION SHALL BE ACCOMMODATED AT THE ASSIGNED BILLETING SCHOOL/QUARTER.

1. In compliance with DepEd Memorandum No. 138, s. 2019, *re: 2020 National Festival of Talents (NFOT)*, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), hereby announces the attached composition of the Official Delegation to the 2020 National Festival of Talents (NFOT) on February 17-21, 2020 in Ilagan City, Isabela (Region II).
2. The number of official delegation is indicated in the attached enclosure. Should there be any unavoidable last minute changes in the participants, the Schools Division Superintendent should inform this office in writing the soonest time possible so that replacement from the next in rank can be decided on immediately not later than January 24, 2020.
3. All the 2020 NFOT qualifiers are advised to bring with them their School ID Card, set of school uniform, medical certificate issued by a government physician and parent's permit and adhere to the necessary requirements stipulated in the attached memorandum.
4. It is recommended that there shall be only one Travel Order for all the participants per division based on the attached enclosures duly approved by the Schools Division Superintendent.
5. It is advised that Schools Division Offices should guarantee that no classes will be left behind and should be managed by available teachers who will replace the coaches involved in the 2020 NFOT to ensure that students still obtain the full benefit of the curriculum-based instruction. Student-participants shall be given additional merits for their attendance to the said activity. They shall be allowed reasonable time

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to make up and comply with other requirements of the different subject areas, including but not limited to quizzes and other examinations that they will miss.

6. Parents and other division or school officials joining the event who are not part of the official regional delegation shall arrange their own accommodation including food, trip tickets, and t-shirts at their own expense.
7. There shall be **no registration fee**, however, traveling expenses of participants going to and from the venue and other incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds/MOOE or other sources of fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. The host region and the schools division shall provide meals in the billeting schools, kits, including identification tags, contest materials as stipulated in the contest mechanics and guidelines, and other related necessary resources in the conduct of the 2020 NFOT. The first meal to be served shall be lunch on **February 17, 2020** while the last meal shall be the a.m. snacks on **February 21, 2020**.
9. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
