- 2. The Schools Division Superintendent of DepEd Division of Baybay City where the school is located is hereby directed to consider this school in the budget preparation for its eventual inclusion in the immediate succeeding General Appropriation Act (GAA).



TITLE : EVALUATION REPORT & RECOMMENDATION FOR THE

ESTABLISHMENT MAGANHAN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, BAYBAY CITY DIVISION

BACKGROUND

In consonance with Article XIV section 1 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution and as stated in DepEd Order No. 36 s. 2013, our Mission, as stewards of the institution is to protect and promote the right of every Filipino to quality, equitable, culture-based, and complete basic education.

Cognizant on this premise, the Barangay Maganhan and nearby barangays have been longing for the establishment of Secondary School to pursue their basic education where their school children in Grade 7 to 10 can access.

The establishment of secondary school in Brgy. Maganhan would surely help the students as well as the community people ease their financial problems specifically on the daily transportation expenses, especially that the nearest secondary school is located at the city proper and the estimated distance is 8 to 10 kilometers away from this barangay and can be accessed thru motor cycle as the only means of transportation just to reach the school.

This situation reflects the actual scenario of a school which need to be given immediate solution to save these school children from dropping out of schooling and at the same time to sustain the Cohort Survival Rate of Magahan Elementary School and other catchment schools.

Maganhan National High School has a total land area of 22,881 sq. meters that could warrant for a secondary school with a projected enrolment of 439.

The desire of the community people of barangay Maganhan and four (4) other catchment barangays translated this into a Joint Resolution No. 20, s. 2018 dated September 18, 2018 requesting the Regional Director for the establishment of Maganhan National High School. In support of the request the Sanguniang Bayan passed a Resolution Nos. 60-A and 70, s. 2019 requesting Congressman Carl Nicolas C. Cari and Municipal Mayor Jose Carlos L. Cari for the creation of Maganhan National High School. Thus the Municipal Mayor Honorable Jose Carlos L. Cari, approved and expressed his strong support for the establishment of Maganhan National High School thru signing of a Memorandum of Agreement by providing sufficient funds for the operation and maintenance of the school within five (5) years, or until such time as the funds for the purpose be incorporated in the national budget.

In response to the urgent need and to address the Basic Education opportunities Baybay City Division through Schools Division Superintendent Raul Agban, organized a team to conduct ocular inspection for the said purpose.

FINDINGS:

1. There are two (2) available classrooms that can be utilized as temporary classrooms for Grade 7. The school site has an area of 22,881 square meters only and ready for school building construction;

A Track Paragraph

- The Local Government Unit of Baybay City assured that the Maganhan National High School will be given school building within one (1) year from the execution of the Memorandum of Agreement.
- 3. The Local Government Unit shall procure educational facilities, furniture, textbooks and instructional materials needed by the students.
- 4. There are 4 catchment barangays as reflected in the documents submitted by the school.
- 5. The school has a certification from Mines and Geosciences Bureau certifying that the school site is appropriate for its intended purpose.

RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the foregoing evaluation and findings, the team respectfully recommends that:

- 1. The school shall be named **MAGANHAN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL** and is authorized to operate effective School Year 2020 2021.
- 2. The school shall offer K to 12 basic Education Curriculum.
- 3. The Schools Division Superintendent shall provide teachers trained on the K to 12Curriculum and consider additional regular teachers to this school to complete the number of teachers required to operate the school.
- 4. The Schools Division Superintendent likewise shall provide school buildings, chairs, textbooks, and other resources to the school.

 The construction of school buildings and other structures shall be in accordance with the recommendations set by Mines and Geosciences Bureau.
