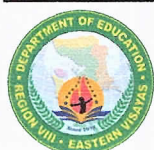

**CONDUCT OF ONLINE TRAINING AND LEARNING INTERVENTION TO THE
 SELECT ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS) GIRL-LEARNERS FROM LEYTE
 AND TACLOBAN CITY DIVISIONS DURING THE COVID-19
 HEALTH EMERGENCY CRISIS**

1. This Office, in partnership with the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), shall conduct an **Online Training and Learning Intervention to the Select Alternative Learning System (ALS) Girl-Learners from Leyte and Tacloban City Divisions during the COVID-19 Health Emergency Crisis on June 4-5, 2020** with the UNESCO, Jakarta Office as the host.
2. The activity will give opportunity to the above-mentioned learners, with the support from their respective teachers, to continue learning despite the restricted movement during this recent COVID-19 pandemic.
3. In this connection, the concerned Schools Division Offices through the Division ALS Focal Persons shall submit the official list of participants to the Curriculum and Learning Management Division through **Mr. Alfredo P.
