CONDUCT OF ONLINE NATIONAL TRAINING OF MASTER TRAINERS ON THE DELIVERY OF ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS) LIFE SKILLS SELF-DIRECTED MODULES

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), in partnership with the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) through the Education Development Center (EDC) as the host, will spearhead the **Conduct of Online National Training of Master Trainers on the Delivery of Alternative Learning System (ALS) Life Skills Self-Directed Modules** on **August 18-20, 2020**.

DATE : July 30, 2020

In line with the **Opportunity 2.0** project of the Department of Education (DepEd) in partnership with the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) through the Education Development Center (EDC), an **Online National Training of Master Trainers on the Delivery of ALS Life Skills Self-Directed Modules** will be conducted by the ALS Task Force on August 5 to 7, 2020 for Batch 1- Mindanao Group, and August 18 to 20, 2020 for Batch 2– Luzon Group, and Batch 3 – Luzon and Visayas Group.

The activity aims to:

1. Orient the ALS Master Trainers on the delivery of life skills self-directed modules, learning assessment and tracking of learners participating in the life skills program; and
2. Develop a roll-out plan with DepEd ALS Task Force for the conduct of the training and distribution of learning package at the division and district levels.

Participants of the above-mentioned activity are the ALS Master Trainers and Regional ALS Focal Persons who participated in the 2018 EDC's Training of Trainers on Life Skills (see attached). They will be provided with mobile load for internet connection during the training chargeable against the project fund.

All one hundred eight (108) participants are required to attend the opening program on August 5, 2020.
