The activity aims to raise the awareness of students regarding current issues and events happening in the country.

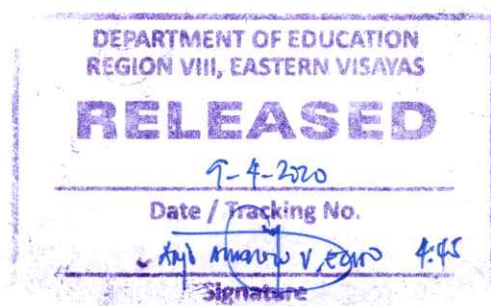

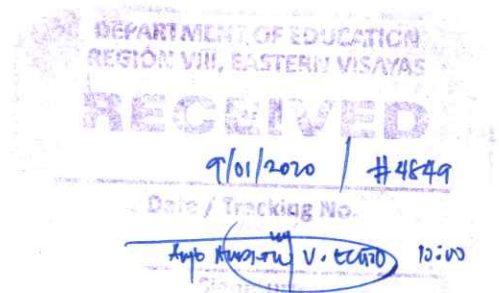
