Other details relative to this activity are stipulated in the above-mentioned letter.

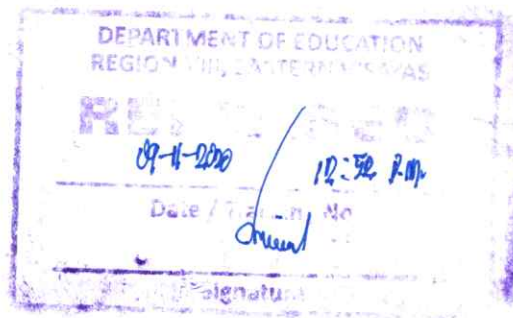
