- 2. The objectives of the training programs are as follows:
  - 2.1 train the grades 3 and 9 receiving teachers on SPED content and pedagogy for them to understand and to apply appropriate strategies and provide reasonable accommodations to learners with disabilities in an inclusive classroom to address their unique needs;
  - 2.2 train SPED teachers of learners with hearing impairment on Filipino Sign Language (FSL);
  - 2.3 orient SPED and general education teachers on the different technologies, soft wares and applications that they can use in teaching learners with disabilities particularly to the blind learners;
  - 2.4 orient parents of learners with disabilities as partners and learning facilitators at home during this COVID-19 pandemic; and
  - 2.5 equip school heads and supervisors as instructional leaders on inclusive and special education for them to provide technical assistance and support to teachers of learners with disabilities
- The link for the online registration of each training program will be provided to the regional supervisor for Special Education program for dissemination to the target participants.
