
REGIONAL MONITORING, EVALUATION AND LEARNING (RMEAL) PHASE 2

To: Director III

All Others Concerned

- 1. With the implementation of the **Regional Monitoring Evaluation**, **Accountability and Learning (RMEAL) Phase I** that has significantly assisted the 13 Schools Division Offices and Schools in setting the directions relative to the delivery of the main learning modality adopted by the Region, the modular distance learning, **this Office announces the conduct of the second phase of the monitoring activity** from **October 13 to November 11**, 2020.
- 2. The objectives of RMEAL Phase 2 are as follows:
 - Conduct monitoring on the implementation of the delivery of learning modality/ties;
 - b. Affirm, confirm and scaffold the activities of the Division relative to the implementation of the distance learning modality; and
 - c. Harvest significant experiences relative to the learning modality/ties as basis for technical assistance.
- 3. This activity is expected to tackle salient issues on how the SDOs/Schools go about education continuity after they have overcome the challenges of the distribution and retrieval stages. The monitoring activity will focus on the issues "in-between" these two stages. Specifically, the following focused questions shall be discussed:
 - a. How can we objectively monitor the learning process?
 - b. How will we monitor the monitors? Monitor the implementers?
 - c. How will we" teach the parents" to teach their children?
 - d. How can we handle the following; the "busy parents, parents with "I don't care" and indifferent attitude about education and parents who are not literate and numerate?
 - e. What are the contextualized assessment tools to be employed in determining the learning outcomes? If after the assessment, majority of the learners are unable to





- cope with the lesson, what will be the next steps that the teachers and administrators do to ensure education continuity?
- f. What are the actions the Divisions can institute /have instituted to safeguard the health and welfare of the implementers?
- g. What are the initiatives that the Schools Division/ Schools have conducted to ensure the continuous support of the community and stakeholders?
- h. What are the emerging issues and concerns in the delivery of educational services of the schools/schools divisions in terms of determining the learning outcomes?
