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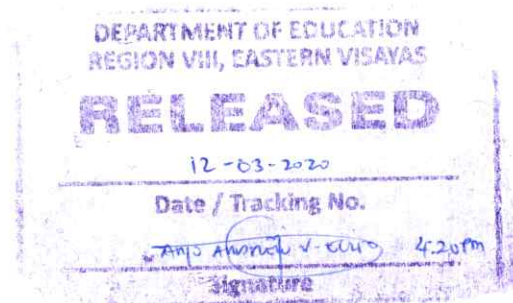

ANNEX 1 – PROGRAM PROFILE

Title: Regional Virtual Training on the Integration of Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE) in the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum (BEC)

Rationale:

Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE) is defined as an age-appropriate, culturally relevant approach to teaching about sexuality and relationships by providing scientifically accurate, realistic, non-judgmental information (UNESCO 2009). The primary goal of CSE is to equip children and young people with the knowledge, attitudes, values and skills necessary for making healthy informed choices about their sexual and reproductive lives and relationships (UNFPA 2014).

Comprehensive sexuality education seeks to:

- Increase learners' knowledge and understanding
- Clarify values and attitudes and enhance self-esteem
- Develop or strengthen life skills
- Develop critical thinking to reduce risks related to poor health outcomes

Studies show that effective comprehensive sexuality education programs can:

- Reduce misinformation
- Increase correct knowledge
- Clarify and strengthen positive values and attitudes
- Increase skills to make informed decisions and act upon them
- Improve perceptions about peer groups and social norms
- Increase communication with parents or other trusted adults

Research also shows that CSE can help to:

- abstain from or delay the debut of sexual relations;
- reduce the instances of unprotected sex, sex for material gain, unwanted pregnancies, and harmful practices including GBV and HTPs;
- reduce the number of sexual partners; and
- increase the use of protection against unintended pregnancy and STIs during sexual intercourse.

Schools provide a practical means of reaching large numbers of young people with comprehensive sexuality education before they become sexually active, as well as providing a structured opportunity within which to do so. Having well-trained, supported and confident teachers who will deliver good quality CSE is critical to leverage such opportunity. Equipping teachers with the knowledge, skills and comfort level, as well as providing them with a stronger professional development and support, will help ensure that learners receive accurate and age-appropriate information that will enable them to make healthy, informed choices about

their sexual and reproductive health and overall well-being and help them achieve their full potential. While there is already a growing interest and confidence among teachers to teach CSE, the actual delivery of the topic has been confronted by several hindrances such as (i) non-adherence to content, sequence, and completeness, (ii) inability of teachers to deliver the topic, and (iii) inhibitions of teachers to discuss sensitive topics. Teachers identified the needs to have curriculum guides and learners' assessment tools. They also identified several training needs on supplementing their technical knowledge and building their ability to communicate and their skill in using participatory methodology.

As public schools transition to alternative learning modalities i.e. blended learning, amid Covid-19 pandemic; the training of teachers for this school year will also shift from conventional face-to-face approach to distance learning. DepEd, together with UNFPA and CHSI, has successfully organized a 2-part webinar on CSE in June 2020. Regional supervisors and CSE focal persons attended the online CSE orientation.

DepEd Central Office launched the online in-service training of teachers on CSE last September to October 2020. Thus, DepEd Regional Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) will conduct this *Regional Virtual Training on the Integration of Comprehensive Sexuality Education Program (CSE) in the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum* on December 14 to 16, 2020. The training aimed to provide the participants with knowledge, skills, attitudes and tools for the effective delivery of school-based CSE.

At the end of the training, the participants will be able to:

- identify core contents, standards and learning competencies of the enhanced Comprehensive Sexuality Education;
- familiarize themselves with the different modules/teaching resources/job aids for CSE orientation sessions, monitoring and evaluation tools of CSE; and
- apply knowledge as facilitators/resource persons for Districts- and School-wide CSE orientation workshops.

Target Participants:

A total of 260 participants comprise of Education Program Supervisors, Public Schools District Supervisors, School Heads/Principals, and Teachers involving the learning areas in Araling Panlipunan, Health, Science, Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao, Kindergarten, and Personality Development for Senior High School.

Duration and indicative dates of implementation:

24 hrs. online session from 8:00-12:00 a.m. and 1:00-5:00pm from December 14 to 16 (Monday to Wednesday)

DATE : **27 August 2020**

The Department of Education, through the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD), and Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD) in coordination with Center for Health Solutions and Innovations Philippines, Inc. (CHSI) and United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), shall conduct a series of capacity-building activities for teachers for the enhanced Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE) curriculum.

To launch the in-service training of teachers, the Department of Education will conduct a **national online training on CSE** from September to October 2020. The training aims to equip our teachers and educators not only with the knowledge and skills on CSE concepts but with beefed up self-efficacy, attitude and tools on the Enhanced Comprehensive Sexuality Education Curriculum using evidence-based pedagogies. Moreover, the participants will also be able to:

1. Identify the core contents, standards and learning competencies of enhanced Comprehensive Sexuality Education;
2. Discuss CSE lesson exemplars and CSE readers for classroom integration.
3. Experience/simulate the different modules/teaching resources/job aids for CSE orientation sessions;
4. Familiarize themselves with the monitoring and evaluation tools of CSE; and
5. Participate in the baseline assessment to be conducted during the training and implementation of CSE.

Select educators from three pilot regions, namely Regions 1, 7 and 11 will be invited. There will be representatives to be invited from non-pilot regions and areas.

Prior to the training, **selected public school teachers and regional supervisors will be invited to participate in the baseline assessment survey of teachers' capacities in teaching CSE.** The baseline assessment is part of the monitoring and evaluation program for CSE implementation. It seeks to identify and understand



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the apprehensions and strengths that teachers have in relation to CSE implementation, and serve as basis for evaluating the effectiveness of the training in future studies. After the data gathering, a digital tool will be created for collecting baseline data in CSE-related LAC sessions that will be made available for teachers who handle CSE learning areas.


