One of the key priorities of the Philippine Government that is aligned with UNICEF 8th Country Programme for Children is to support the implementation of the Mother Tongue-Based Multilingual Education (MTB-MLE) Policy for early grade learners.

Specifically, the creation of MTB-MLE Support for the Development of Storybooks in Local Languages aims to achieve the following:

A. Improved capacity of schools and communities in the development of storybooks in local languages; and

B. Increased access of Kinder to Grade 1 learners to quality storybooks (both printed and digitized copies).

In line with this, the Summer Institute of Linguistic (SIL-LEAD) is engaged to undertake the following:

- 1) At the regional level, support selected focus areas i.e., Northern Samar, Zamboanga del Norte, and Angeles City in:
 - a. Capacity building of 90 recipient schools/communities (30 schools each from the three focus areas) in the development of quality storybooks in local languages;
 - b. Co-development of storybooks by schools and communities with the provision of technical expertise in terms of content development, illustration, and printing; and

- c. Digitization and accessibility of the storybooks in the existing online platforms.
- 2) At the national level, support the formulation of the National Training Module for Schools and Communities in developing quality storybooks in local languages.

Enclosed is the detailed Terms of Reference (TOR) of the SIL-LEAD Consultancy.

As part of quality assurance mechanisms, an Advisory Group with representatives from the different offices will be formed:

- a. DepEd Central Office representatives from the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD), Bureau of Learning Resources (BLR), and IPSEO;
- b. DepEd Division Offices of Angeles City, Northern Samar, and Zamboanga del Norte;
- c. Ms. Maria Mercedes Azadon, MTB-MLE Consultant (Formulation of Operations Manual); and
- d. Representatives from UNICEF.

The Advisory Group will meet at strategic periods during the course of the consultancy in order to (1) review and approve the key deliverables; (2) identify and recommend primary and secondary resources; and (3) ensure that issues raised on the terms of reference shall be addressed.

Concerned Bureaus/Offices are requested to submit the names of the permanent and alternate representatives together with the comments on the draft Inception Report to the Advisory Group through the BLD on or before February 26, 2021.
