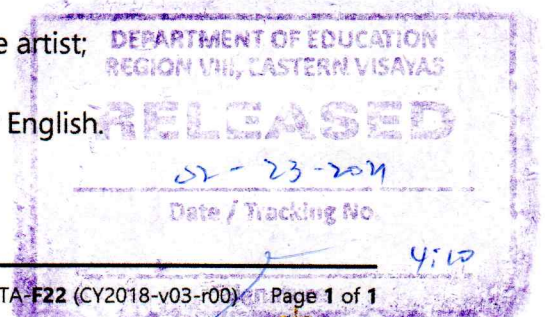

REGIONAL ARTS CONTESTS IN CELEBRATION OF THE 65TH ANNIVERSARY OF PEACE TREATY BETWEEN PHILIPPINES AND JAPAN

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum, DM-OUCI-2021-416, dated December 29, 2020 re: **Invitation to Join the National Arts Contest in Celebration of the 65th Anniversary of Peace Treaty Between Philippines and Japan**, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) shall conduct a **Regional Arts Contest in Celebration of the 65th Anniversary of Peace Treaty Between Philippines and Japan** with the theme **"Dakilang Lahi."**
2. The activity aims to showcase the talents in painting of both learners and teachers and discover from their own perspective on the importance of the diplomatic relations between Philippines and Japan through their artwork.
3. The details on the schedule and mechanics of the said contest are as follows:
 1. The Regional Arts Contest with the theme "Dakilang Lahi", shall be held on March 25, 2021.
 2. There shall be only three (3) entries for each division for each category: elementary learner, high school learner, and teacher.
 3. All entries/paintings shall be original on a canvas with 24 X 36 inches' frame, using only acrylic or oil paint.
 4. All entries for the whole duration of the actual painting shall be recorded and shall be emailed at clmd.region8@deped.gov.ph and nova.jorge@deped.gov.ph on or before March 22, 2021.
 5. The division entries shall indicate the following information in their recorded output:
 - a. Full name, age, grade level, and address of the artist;
 - b. Title of the painting; and
 - c. Brief description of the painting in Tagalog or English.



6. The champion for each category shall represent DepEd Region VIII for the 2nd National Arts Contests which shall be held from April to May 2021 with exhibit at DepEd Central Office.
 7. All regional winners will receive Certificate of Recognition, and Certificate of Participation will be given to the non-winners including the school.
 8. The criteria for judging are as follows:
 - a. 35%- Relevance to the theme;
 - b. 30%- Originality;
 - c. 25%- Creativity and presentation; and
 - d. 10%- Over-all impact.
4. For further information on the 2nd National Arts Contest, refer to the attached Memorandum.
5. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.

SUBJECT : INVITATION TO JOIN THE NATIONAL ARTS CONTEST IN
CELEBRATION OF THE 65TH ANNIVERSARY OF PEACE TREATY
BETWEEN PHILIPPINES AND JAPAN

DATE : 29 DECEMBER 2020

In 2021, the Philippines will celebrate its 65th year anniversary of Peace Treaty with Japan. To mark the significance of this event, this office invites all DepEd teachers and learners to participate in the culminating activity through a National Arts Contest and get a chance to win 500K for the winning art piece for each category.

Similar to the conduct of last year's event, below are the details for the 2nd National Arts Contest:

1. The 2nd National Art Contest with the theme, **Dakilang Lahi**, shall be held from April to May 2021 with exhibit at the DepEd Central Office.
2. All entries/paintings shall be on canvas, with 24 x 36 inches frame, using only either acrylic or oil paint.
3. All entries must be endorsed by the region or at the regional level only. Divisions and schools are not encouraged to send their entries directly to the contest committee.
4. There shall be three classifications -Elementary, High School, and Teacher categories.
5. The champion for each category shall receive 500k while the 1st and 2nd runners up for each category shall receive 150k and 50k, respectively. Non-winners shall receive 3,000 each.
6. Trophies and other subsidy shall be provided and covered by the sponsor.

7. Awarding ceremony is tentatively scheduled in May, 2021 at the DepEd Central Office.
8. All winning art pieces shall be the sole property of the sponsor/sponsor agency.
9. Each region may send contestant/s based on the following categories:
 - Elementary school category - 1 contestant
 - High school category - 1 contestant
 - Teachers category - 1 contestant.

This National Arts Contest will not only showcase the talents of both Filipino learners and teachers in the arts but more importantly, discover from their perspective, through their artwork, how they reflect on the depth of friendship between the two countries. As it is, this Department wishes to strengthen the ties that bind between the Philippines and Japan through the lens of a Filipino learner and a teacher, as artists.

The specific date and venue of the Judging of entries and Awarding Ceremony will be announced through a separate memo.
