

Important Notes:

- 1) All participating **learners** must be **active in school-based organizations** like SSG/SPG, YES-O, BSP/GSP and the likes within the past one year but has **limited knowledge/engagement in climate change adaptation and mitigation**.
- 2) The school selected should be a combination of schools with excellent implementation of the Department's Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation program, including but not limited to Disaster Risk Reduction and Management, Gulayan sa Paaralan, Solid Waste Management, and Tree Growing, and those schools needing improvement.
- 3) Each **learner** must be **accompanied by their adviser**.
- 4) Each learner and teacher must be able to agree to the terms itemized in the consent and confirmation form. Thus, they need to fulfill the role expected of them.
- 5) **Be mindful of the gender distribution of the participants** to ensure that all genders are represented.



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
