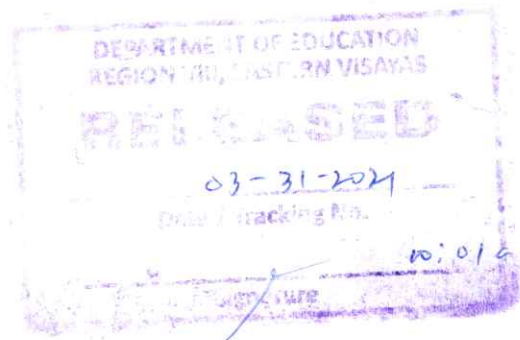

**2021 UNESCO-JAPAN PRIZE ON EDUCATION FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT**

The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) announces the call for nominations on the UNESCO-Japan Prize on Education for Sustainable Development (ESD).

ESD empowers learners with knowledge, skills, values, and attitudes to take informed decisions and make responsible actions for environmental integrity, economic viability, and a just society empowering people of all genders, for present and future generations, while respecting cultural diversity.

The Prize is funded by the Government of Japan and consists of three biennial awards of US \$50,000 for each recipient.

The three winners will be selected by the Director-General of UNESCO based on recommendations made by an independent international jury, consisting of five experts from all geographic regions.

The online nominations must be submitted by UNESCO Permanent Delegations, in consultation with the Philippine National Commission for UNESCO or Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) in official partnership with UNESCO by April 30, 2021 (Midnight, Paris Time). Self-nominations are not accepted.
