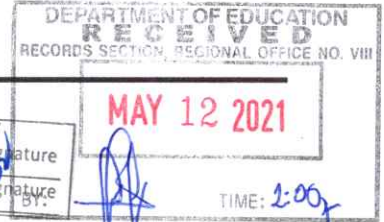

Enclosure 1. Video Message Guidelines

1. Speak clearly and at a normal pace. You may deliver your message in English, Filipino, Taglish, or your local language.
2. If the message was recorded in your local language, we would like to request your office to send us a document with the English translation so we can add the subtitle.
3. Your video must be saved in one of the following formats: .mov, .mpg, .avi, or .mp4 (.mp4 is the preferred format)
4. The suggested length is less than 5 minutes.
5. Record the video preferably with your smartphone for better resolution. You may also record through your laptop, webcam device, or a digital meeting platform such as Zoom.
6. The video message must not be sensitive to date or time, as it will be played on the synchronous sessions for both Batch 1 and Batch 2.
