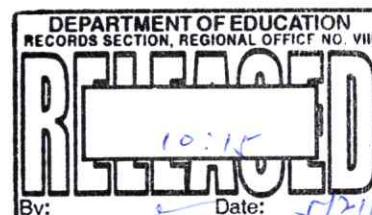

### **ACTIVITY INFORMATION NOTE**

#### **PROJECT BACKGROUND**

The **Technical Support to Alternative Learning System 2.0 (TS-ALS 2.0) Project** is being implemented under the tripartite cooperation agreement among the Department of Education (DepEd, UNICEF Philippines, and SEAMEO INNOTECH).

The TS-ALS 2.0, which is being implemented under the technical leadership of the DepEd ALS Task Force, intends to enhance the capacities of ALS implementers—including mobile teachers, instructional managers, district ALS coordinators (DALSCs) and Education Program Specialists for ALS (EPSAs)—to empower out-of-school children, youth and adult (OSCYA) learners to continue learning in a manner, time and place suitable to their preference and circumstances, and for OSCYA to achieve their goals of improving their quality of life and becoming productive contributors to society.

Specifically, the TS-ALS 2.0 project aims to support the DepEd Learning Continuity Plan for ALS and roll-out of the ALS 2.0 Five-Year Strategic Roadmap. The project is designed to accomplish this goal through the following interventions: (Component 1) capacity building program for ALS implementers on the use of mobile technology for teaching and learning (MT4T) and digital citizenship, and (Component 2) technical assistance on the design and utilization of the ALSware Teaching and Learning Resource Package.

This activity forms part of the TS-ALS 2.0 Component 2.

#### **ACTIVITY RATIONALE AND OBJECTIVES**

Through the TS-ALS 2.0 Component 2, the project aims to strengthen ALS learning delivery by helping ALS learners gain access to relevant learning materials. The ALSware package was developed to provide easy access to useful and relevant learning modules, supplementary materials, instructional tools and equipment, and other resources curated for ALS teachers and learners.

The ALSware package is being provided as a pilot initiative in selected DepEd schools divisions: 1) Angeles City, 2) Northern Samar, 3) Samar, 4) Zamboanga City, 5) Zamboanga del Norte, and 6) Cagayan de Oro City.

To facilitate the use of the ALSware package, a Guidebook for Using the ALSware is being made available for all ALSware recipients, Division ALS Coordinators/Focal Persons, and regional/division/district key officials and supervisors. The Guidebook provides a snapshot of the purpose, design, and contents of the ALSware. A monitoring and evaluation design and tools are likewise included to guide the immediate and succeeding monitoring activities in relation to the pilot use of the ALSware package.

This Ceremonial Turnover cum Orientation Program is designed to officially turn over the ALSware packages and to provide a walk-through on the use of the resources. Specifically, the program aims to:

1. Formally turn over the ALSware Teaching and Learning Resources to DepEd ALS.
2. Orient ALSware recipients on the contents/features of the ALSware package, as well as on the proper utilization, storage, and care and maintenance of the resources.
3. Orient ALSware recipients on the ALSware monitoring and evaluation design and tools, and the recipients' roles and responsibilities in the monitoring and evaluation of the ALSware package.
4. Allow the ALSware beneficiaries/recipients to accomplish and submit the ALSware Readiness Monitoring tool.

  - Selected ALS learners (two learners per site)
2. Key officials and representatives of the DepEd ALS Task Force
3. Key officials and representatives of UNICEF Philippines
4. Key officials and representatives of SEAMEO INNOTECH

## **EXPECTED OUTCOMES, METHODS AND INDICATIVE PROGRAMME**

### **Expected Outcomes**

By the end of the program, it is expected that DepEd participants and ALSware beneficiaries should have:

1. taken full ownership and accountability of the ALSware Teaching and Learning Resources, including appropriate utilization, care and maintenance, and monitoring and evaluation.
2. gained knowledge and understanding of the contents/features of the ALSware package, as well as its proper utilization, storage, and care and maintenance.
3. been familiarized with the ALSware monitoring and evaluation design and tools and their roles and responsibilities in the monitoring and evaluation of the ALSware package.
4. completed and submitted the ALSware Readiness Monitoring tool.

### **Methods**

The ALSware Ceremonial Turnover cum Orientation Program will be conducted via online through Microsoft Teams (MS Teams). Participants will need to have an Internet bandwidth (up/down) of at least 2.0 Mbps to fully participate in the program.

The activity consists of three parts to be held in two half-days on May 27 and 28, 2021 as follows:

#### *Day 1*

- Part 1: Ceremonial turnover of the ALSware Teaching and Learning Resources to DepEd ALS
