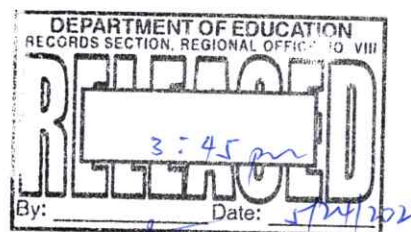

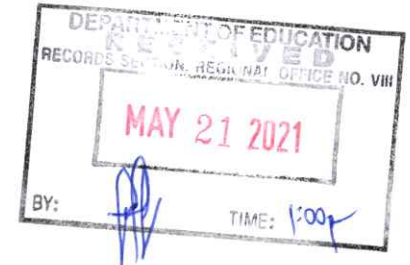

Dear DepEd Regional Directors,


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free training is open to all, and if your stakeholders would want to participate, kindly have them pre-register in the online link indicated above.
