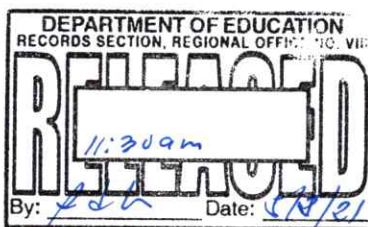
- i. promote research and publication among teachers in Basic and Higher Education as part of the teachers' continuing professional development;

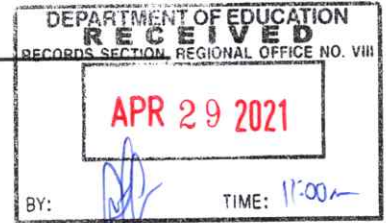
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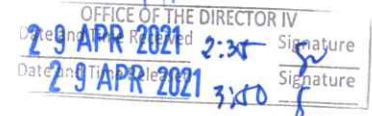

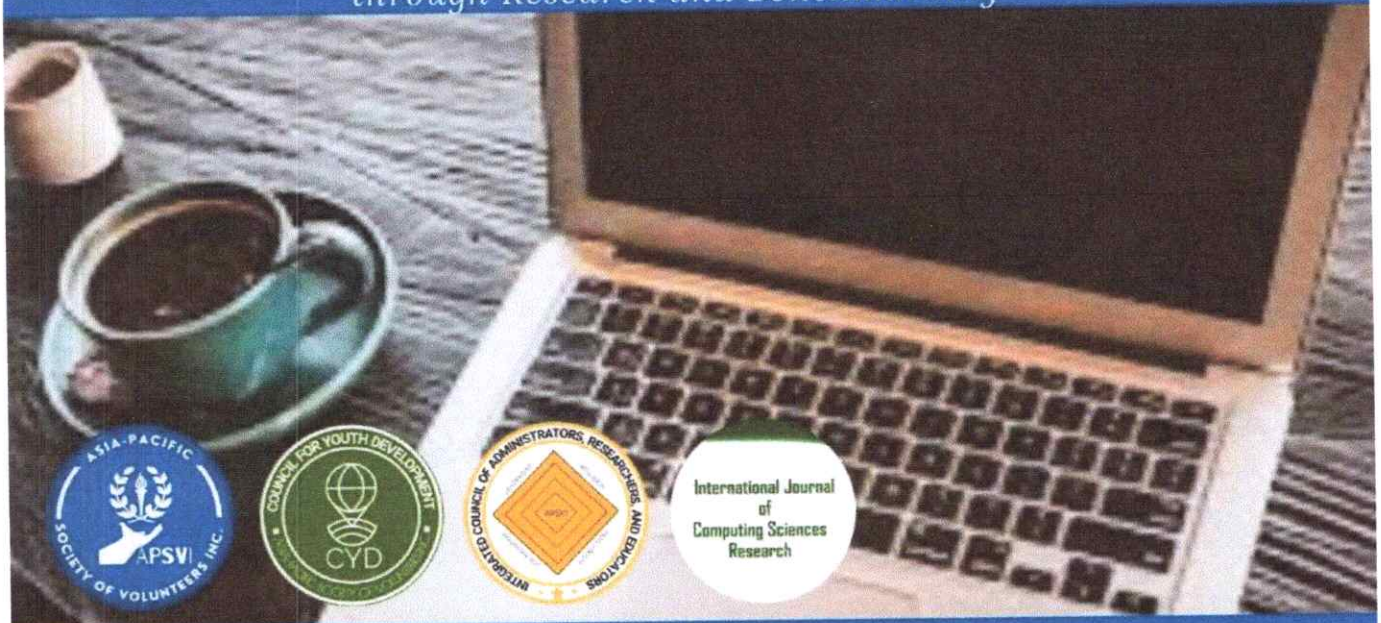

It should be typed in Word document with the following mechanics: Title (with researcher's name, affiliation, academic institution, and e-mail address); Abstract (150 to 250 words); Keywords (up to 5 words only, alphabetical); Font style and size - Arial; 12; Spacing - 1.15; Margin - 1.5 (left) x 1 (right) x 1 (top) x 1 (bottom); and Paper size - 8.5 x 11.

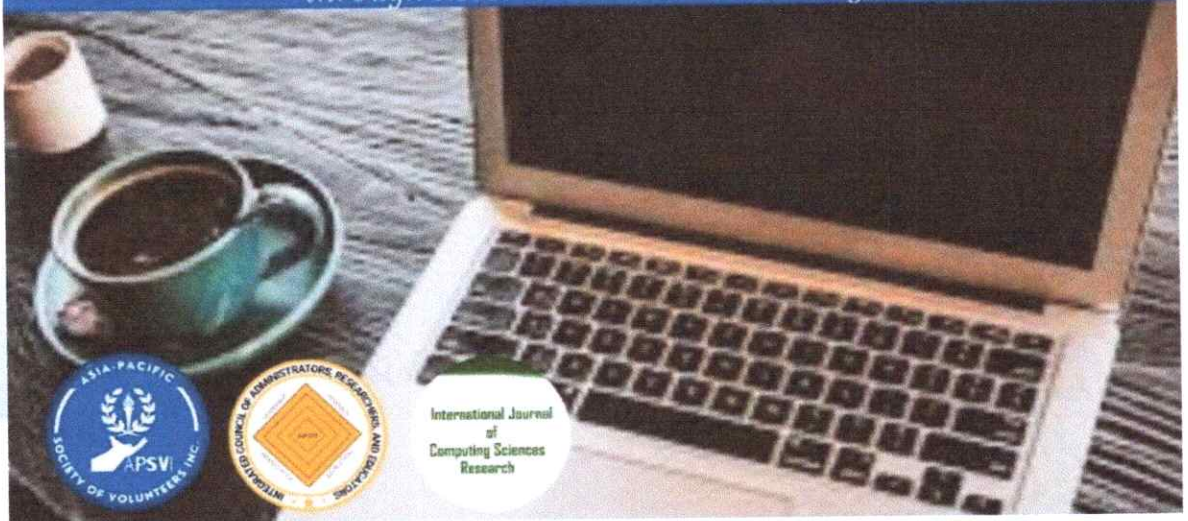
