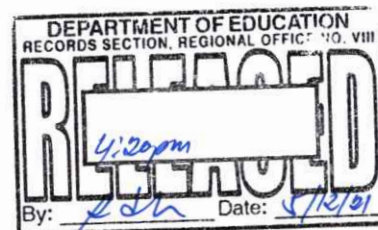

This is with reference to the communication from the SEAMEO INNOTECH regarding request for information dissemination of the Online Courses for Teachers and School Heads of Southeast Asia: Philippines.

SEAMEO INNOTECH joins the education community in responding to the challenges of these times. We remain committed to supporting the region through needs-based and innovative capacity building and learning services. As such, we are pleased to announce two online course offerings for the teachers and school heads of Southeast Asia:

1. **For School Heads: *Managing Teacher Performance in Challenging Times*** is an online course based on the Competency Framework for Southeast Asian School Heads (CFSH). It is the first course under the Managerial Leadership program, and it aims to help school heads manage, support, and develop teachers through a balance between a systematic performance management process and a more empathic and human-centered approach.
2. **For Teachers: *SEA-TCF Course 1*** is an online course based on the Southeast Asian Teacher Competency Framework (SEA-TCF). It is a foundational course that aims to develop the core essential

competencies of high-performing teachers in the region: *know and understand what I teach, help my students learn, engage the community, and become a better teacher every day.*

These courses will run **from 22 June to 21 August 2021** through iFLEX which is the learning management system of SEAMEO INNOTECH. Each participant will spend a total of 60 learning hours for the whole duration of the course.
