- 1. As a key feature of the K to 12 Basic Education Program, nurturing holistically developed Filipinos means going beyond basic competencies and equipping them with knowledge, skills, values, and attitudes that are integral for success in today's fast-changing world. Opportunities to learn 21st-century skills (21CS) are essential, and so appropriate assessment practices that support the teaching and development of these skills need to be implemented.
- 2. Anchored on the Department of Education's (DepEd) Sulong EduKalidad initiative, the Bureau of Learning Delivery Teaching and Learning Division (BLD-TLD) will spearhead the Development of Performance Tasks for Assessing 21st Century Skills in Key Stage 2 as an important step towards promoting the integration of 21CS in teaching, learning and assessment in schools.
- 3. Specifically, the objectives of this project are the following:
  - a. Develop capacity in performance assessment among a network of teachers
  - Build a repository of standards-aligned performance tasks that schools may access to support 21CS development in Grades 4, 5 and 6
  - Foster the creation and use of performance tasks to improve instructional practices and support deeper student learning outcomes

- 4. In this regard, the BLD-TLD Project Team is requesting for expressions of interest from qualified teachers who wish to be part of the said project. For Phase 1, this **call for writers** is open to all public elementary school teachers currently teaching English, Filipino, Mathematics and/or Science in Grades 4 to 6. Junior and Senior High School teachers in these learning areas who wish to contribute may also apply.
- 5. Candidates must possess the following qualifications:
  - a. At least 5 years of accumulated teaching experience
  - b. Bachelor's and/or graduate degree in the relevant discipline
  - Sufficient understanding of the curriculum framework in one's discipline, including pedagogical and assessment approaches
  - d. Experience in creating own assessment resources for learners, particularly authentic performance tasks
  - e. Fluency in Filipino and English, both written and spoken
  - f. Working knowledge of MS Office tools and Google Suite applications
  - g. Able to work independently and with others in a team
- 6. All interested teachers are required to submit the following items, either in Word or PDF, to the BLD-TLD Project Team for evaluation.
  - a. Curriculum vitae
  - b. A one-page letter of intent expressing one's motivation for joining the project and sharing relevant experience in designing and implementing classroom-based assessments
  - c. One (1) <u>original</u> performance task with a rubric designed for Grade 4, 5 or 6 learners in the relevant learning area
  - d. One (1) recommendation letter from the principal/supervisor, or an equivalent endorsement
- 7. All required documents must be sent **no later than 25 June 2021** via <a href="https://tinyurl.com/21CSPTCallforWriters">https://tinyurl.com/21CSPTCallforWriters</a>. Submissions received beyond this date will no longer be considered.
- 8. All applications shall be sifted based on compliance with the requirements. Incomplete submissions will not be evaluated. Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted.
