The National Economic Development Authority (NEDA) through its -Social Development Staff is conducting a research which aims to identify factors affecting the education outcomes of Filipino students. Specifically, the study will a) analyze the education outcomes vis-à-vis reforms in basic education; b) compare Philippine practices with selected high performing countries; and c) provide recommendations to improve education outcomes.

Part of the research is to conduct interviews with select DepEd personnel from the field offices to gain valuable inputs that may contribute to the study. DepEd Secretary Briones has granted the approval for NEDA to conduct the said interviews which is scheduled between July 6 to 16, 2021.
