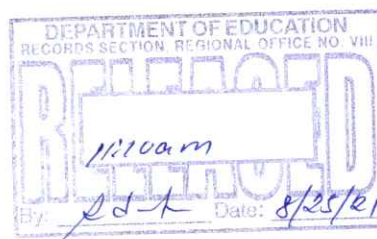
The target participants are the teachers in the field of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) from both public and private schools.


