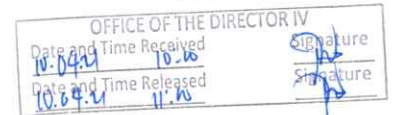

There were 32 success stories selected from the total of 72 submitted videos in compliance to the memorandum issued last July 30, 2021 with a follow up memo on September 3, 2021. These videos were selected based on the following criteria:

- The four (4) success stories must come from the batches of SHS Graduates.
- The four (4) SHS graduates must have exhibited good moral character and must not have been charged of any administrative, civil, or criminal case.
- The success stories are exemplary, worth emulating, and inspiring for the SHS students and graduates to achieve their own success.

These videos will be showcased in the launching program of these SHS Graduate Success Stories on October 12, 2021

We are also planning to use this video message in other publicity materials of these SHS Graduate Success Stories like in the DepEd website, newsletter, and advocacy videos for SHS students
