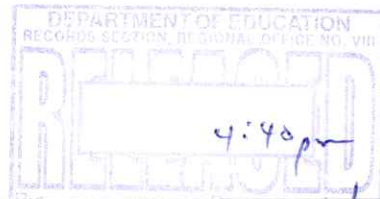

The Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD) is mandated to support the field offices and schools in the delivery of basic education services for learners in different learning delivery modalities. With the issuance of Joint Memorandum Circular No. 01, s. 2021, *Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of Limited Face-to-Face Learning Modality*, the Department reiterates the mechanisms and standards on the resumption of face-to-face classes. In order to ensure effective, efficient, and safe implementation, the BLD will conduct a **Virtual National Orientation-Workshop on the Teaching-Learning Component of the Pilot Implementation of Limited Face-to-Face Classes (Blended Learning) on October 27 – 28, 2021.**

Specifically, the orientation aims to:

- discuss the salient features of the JMC No. 1, s. 2021 relative to the teaching and learning delivery, and
- address concerns and challenges on the part of field implementers on the conduct of the limited face-to-face classes.
