

In response to the call to intensify the advocacy for reading under the *Hamon: Bawat Bata Bumabasa (3Bs Initiatives)* issued under DepEd Memorandum No. 173, s. 2019, the External Partnerships Service (EPS) has committed to make every learner a reader by engaging partners and stakeholders to promote the culture of reading.

Brigada Paghasa, as a form of **Brigada Eskwela**, is an after-school reading program that envisions bringing together education partners and experts to help learners read and become functionally literate.

Brigada Pagbasa intends to cater to learners who are below 18 years old, including those who are under the Alternative Learning System (ALS), focusing on non-readers and struggling readers from both formal and non-formal education systems nationwide.

DepEd, through the EPS, in partnership with World Vision Development Foundation, Inc., shall be conducting the **National** *Brigada Pagbasa* **Orientation** in four clusters in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao on the following schedules:

Cluster 4 Mindanao (DepEd Regions IX, X, XI, XII and CARAGA)	October 21, 2021	DepEd Regional Office of CARAGA, SDO Butuan City

- 1. understand the purpose and goal of the Brigada Pagbasa advocacy;
- 2. identify learners who will attend Brigada Pagbasa;
- 3. identify number of parents and volunteers who will participate in the *Brigada Pagbasa* Reading Remediation Program;

- 5. address the literacy/reading gaps of elementary learners.
