REGIONAL WEBINAR ON MENSTRUAL HYGIENE MANAGEMENT(MHM) WASH IN SCHOOL(WinS) AND COMPREHENSIVE SEXUALITY EDUCATION (CSE)

1. Cognizant to DepEd Memorandum No. 194, s. 2018 re: Implementing Guidelines to DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2016, this Office, through the Field Technical Assistance Division (FTAD) in coordination with the Education Support Services Division-Health and Nutrition Unit (ESSD-HNU), CLMD, UNICEF and CHSI Philippines will conduct a Regional Webinar on Menstrual Hygiene Management, WASH in School and Comprehensive Sexuality Education on November 4-5, 8-9, 2021 via Zoom.
2. This activity aims to:
 - a. review the rationale, goals, and program of Menstrual Hygiene Management, WASH in School, and Comprehensive Sexuality Education;
 - b. discuss the integration process of MHM topics/messages in lesson plans/weekly home learning plans;
 - c. familiarize with the MHM learning delivery tools & resources, KwenTuruan rollout mechanics, and Monitoring & Evaluation tools;
 - d. enhance the School Improvement Plans and WinS Plans of participating schools by strengthening the MHM component.
3. The participants to this activity are the Division EPSvr in Science, MAPEH and EPP, CLMD EPSvr, FTAD EPSvr, PSDSs, selected 1000 Elem. Schools (40 Schools allotted for each City SDO and 120 Schools are allotted per provincial SDO) each school must have 5 pax namely: SH, WASH Coordinator, Grade 5 teachers in Science, MAPEH and EPP.



4. Schools Division Superintendents are enjoined to submit the list of participating schools allotted per division following the attached template in excel format via email to ftad.region8@deped.gov.ph on or before October 29, 2021.
5. Meals and snacks of RO participants and other administrative costs are chargeable against RD`s discretionary Funds, while Schools Division participants to local funds or other sources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
6. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.


