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

- 1. - 1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), encourages all the Schools Division Offices to conduct a **Division-Based Capability Building for Kindergarten Teachers in Handling Co-Curricular Activities** within the first and second quarter of FY 2019 and ascertain its implementation at the school level through a conduct of the **Regional Slumber Party** every October of the year to coincide with the National Children's Month Celebration.
- 2. The main objectives of the activity are to equip the Kindergarten Teachers with the knowledge, skills, values, and attitudes in story writing and telling, teaching Mother Goose Rhymes, and to prepare themselves for the conduct of a slumber party which will showcase the skills of kindergarten learners.
- 3. The following topics must be discussed during the division-based activity:
 - a. Review of the Blocks of Time;
 - b. The What and How of Writing Short Stories;
 - c. Teaching Mother Goose Rhyme;
 - d. The Art of Story Telling;
 - e. Games and Activities for Kindergarten Learners;
 - f. Conduct of Slumber Party; and
 - g. School Learning Action Cell.
- 4. A Narrative Activity Report with still pictures and/ or video document duly endorsed by the Schools Division Superintendent to this Office c/o Dr. Alejandrito L. Yman, CLMD Chief, a week after the conduct of the activities.
- 5. The Regional Monitors and Learning Facilitators during the regional capability building whose names are listed in the table are advised to join the monitoring and evaluation of the conduct of the regional slumber party.
