The target participants are those in-charge of research and the school, district and division DRRM Coordinators.

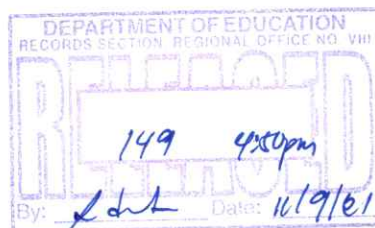
