

LGIS Leadership and Governance International Standards has made a great stride in steering Internationalization services and provides solutions to global challenges faced by the education sector. LGIS makes our software resources available to all its member educational institutions and provides a solid base on which innovation can thrive. We are happy to support initiatives on Internationalization of the Philippine educational system.

We contacted the office of **DIR. MARGARITA CONSOLACION C. BALLESTEROS Director IV of Department of Education International Cooperation Office** for our internationalization efforts for the country. We forwarded the proposal on LGIS softwares and her recommendation is to contact your office for you to assess the benefits of the system to the schools in the region.

Delivery of learning is affected by the continuing global health emergencies. The need for modalities that could best meet the requirements of teachers for instruction effectiveness and at the same time assure the continuing safety of learners has been one of the most compelling challenges faced by schools today. We at LGIS believe that this could be the best time for other regions to benefit from our **ONLINE GRADING SYSTEM** which has been used internationally and in some DepED schools in Mindanao since 2016. The utilization of the system is geared towards the basic delivery of education services to all teachers and learners particularly in the encoding of grades.

The system is a web-based (online) grading system designed for Public and Private schools. All teachers can access the program 24/7 anytime and anywhere using their mobile phones,

laptops, desktops or tablets. The system highlights ACCOUNTABILITY, ACCURACY and RELIABILITY of data, and EFFICIENCY. It reduces the time and effort of teachers in the making of students' grades. It is a tool that provides accurate computation of grades encoded by all teachers in different Learning Areas. Reports generated are based on the actual data encoded by the teachers and consolidated reports for the adviser are automatically generated.

We propose the following implementation guidelines for DepEd Regional Offices' perusal:

1. Regional offices are encouraged to endorse to the Division the utilization of the software as a grading system in the creation of the Learners Progress Report Card and Learners Permanent record.
2. A subscription fee to cover the domain cost, hosting, maintenance and server cost, a subscription fee is charged in the amount of Php1,500 only (One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos only) per school per month.
3. For the benefit of the schools and immediate implementation, the expenses incurred in the utilization of the online grading system in schools shall be charged against the local school MOOE funds subject to accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. We propose that payment is centralized and LGIS collection for subscription shall be collected from the Division Offices.
5. Upon Installation, we shall be collecting a 2 months subscription fee per school for the set up fee and advance 1 month subscription fee. The next payment shall be collated on the 3rd month.
