
1. 3. The original and hard copies of the above-mentioned forms and supporting attachments shall be submitted to the Regional Office (Attention PPRD). Meanwhile, to save



expenses for the printing of the research report/paper, the Final Report based on Annex 6 of DO 16, s. 2017 shall be uploaded/submitted in electronic copy/PDF format through the link: https://bit.ly/3yz52Yo. Another link shall be provided for the submission of the evaluated final paper required for the issuance of the Certificate of Completion. All forms and supporting attachments can be downloaded from https://bit.ly/BERFLiquidation.

4. To expedite and streamline the release of the remaining amount for the BERF-funded Basic Researches, there shall be one processing to be made for the 2nd and 3rd tranches. 
