
General rules and guidelines of the different contest are stipulated herein.



Due to the online nature of the Pakaritay 2022, the organizers anticipate possible technical difficulties that might be encountered; thus, the coaches may raise their concerns by emailing us at ups.pakaritay@gmail.com. The participants and coaches are also encouraged to check the official Facebook page of Pakaritay 2022, https://www.facebook.com/Pakaritay, for official announcements and updates. Note that no changes to the rules and guidelines shall be made one week before the 1st day of Pakaritay 2022.

The Zoom credentials for all competitions shall be sent to the coaches and participants at the first day of the program.

Due to the pandemic, the organizers will communicate with the winners and their coaches on how the prizes will be delivered.


QUIZ SHOW

(ELEMENTARY and JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL)

- 1. UP Sidlangan Quiz Show is a regional inter-school competition primarily academic in nature.
- 2. The Quiz Show is open to all public and private elementary and junior high school students in the Eastern Visayas Region.
- 3. Each school must have three (3) representatives.
- 4. Questions would range from the following sets of topics:

Elementary Level

- Mathematics and Science
 - General Mathematics
 - Basic Arithmetic
 - Basic Geometry
 - Ratio, Rates and Percentages
 - General Science
 - Life Science
 - Earth and Space Science
- Humanities, Arts, and Social Sciences
 - General Information
 - History and Current Events
 - Geography
 - Music and Art
 - Language and Literature (English and Filipino)



Junior High School Level

- Mathematics, Science and Technology, and Economics
 - Algebra
 - Geometry
 - Trigonometry
 - Logarithm
 - Biology
 - Chemistry
 - Physics
 - Technology
 - Economics
- Humanities and Social Sciences
 - General Information
 - History and Current Events
 - Geography
 - Language and Literature (English and Filipino)
- 5. ALL participants are **required** to attend the <u>opening program</u> on the first day of the event. Failure to do so would result in **immediate disqualification**.
- 6. There will be two rounds, Elimination and Team Finals, which will be held via Zoom.

I. ELIMINATION ROUND

- a. The elimination round will be answered individually and will consist of forty (40) questions to be administered through Google Forms. The participants will be given one (1) hour to answer and submit the form.
- b. During the conduct of this round, all participants must have a device with a camera. The purpose of this device shall be only limited in answering the questions, and monitoring. Other than the Google Forms and Zoom, no other tabs/applications shall be opened during the activity.
- c. In cases of clarification, participants may raise them in Zoom through chat to a designated person. Participants must not raise them vocally.
- d. A reminder at 10, 5, and 2-minute marks will be made to notify participants of the remaining time.
- e. By the end of one hour, the Google Forms will be automatically submitted. Every correct answer shall merit a point. Incorrect answers will merit no point.
- f. The top three (3) scorers will be recognized at the awarding ceremony on the last day of the event.
- g. Points gathered by each school representative will be added to determine their cumulative scores.


h. The **top 5 teams** with the highest cumulative scores shall proceed to the Final Round. In case there are only 5 or less teams from the start, the Elimination Round shall be skipped to the Final Round.

II. TEAM FINALS

- a. Schools shall be represented by only one team composed of three (3) bonafide students of the said schools. Alternate representatives are not allowed.
- b. Representatives of each school are highly encouraged to gather in one place for easier communication.
- c. There will be three rounds: easy, average, difficult. Participants are given 20, 40, and 60 seconds to answer each question in these rounds, respectively.
- d. There will be twenty (20) questions: ten (10) for easy round and five (5) for the average and difficult rounds. The point system are as follows:

- e. The quiz master will read the questions only once. Participants may start answering as soon as the question is flashed on their screens.
- f. Answers shall be submitted via private chat to a designated person.
- g. Answers to Mathematics and other numeric questions shall be rounded off to the nearest unit, unless otherwise specified.
- h. Only full name answers shall be considered as valid, unless otherwise specified.
- i. In case of protests, participants must unmute themselves to be recognized. Any protests raised when the next question has already been read will not be entertained.
- j. Coaching or any form of cheating will not be tolerated. Once caught, the team will automatically be disqualified.
- k. Scores will be tallied and announced at the end of each round.
- 1. The top three (3) teams will be declared as winners in this year's Pakaritay Quiz Show.
- m. In case of a tie, clincher questions will be given until the tie is broken.
- n. Should there be unforeseen difficulties regarding the conduct of this event, the Board of Judges will have full prerogative to pass resolutions or meet contingencies.
- o. The decision of the Board of Judges will be final and irrevocable.




ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION

(ELEMENTARY, JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL and SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL)

- 1. The Essay Writing Contest is open to all public and private elementary and secondary schools in Biliran, Leyte and Samar.
- 2. Each school can send only one representative.
- 3. The topic will be given on the actual writing session itself. Thus, the topic could range from politics to entertainment to the latest social issues to anything under the sun.
- 4. Only the use of a black ballpen, and A4-size bond paper are allowed.
- 5. The essay should not be more than 350 words, articles and prepositions included. The final output must be in black ink.
- 6. All contestants shall be observed via Zoom. The camera shall be tilted to where the contestants will be writing their essays so as to monitor any acts of cheating, plagiarism, or the likes. This shall be set-up 10 minutes before the contest proper.
- 7. All contestants will be given two (2) hours to write their essay and submit their scanned outputs. The Google Forms submission bin will be provided by the facilitator.
- 8. The criteria for judging will be as follows:

- 9. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.
- 10. The winning contestants will be awarded medals and Certificates of Recognition. Their coaches will be given Certificates of Recognition. All the participants will receive Certificates of Participation.
- 11. ALL participants are required to attend the opening program on the first day of the event. Failure to do so would mean disqualification of the participant(s).




PATIMPALAK SA PAGSUSULAT NG SANAYSAY

(ELEMENTARY, JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL, at SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL)

- 1. Ang Patimpalak sa Pagsusulat ng Sanaysay ay bukas sa lahat ng pampubliko at pribadong paaralang elementarya at pangsekundarya sa Biliran, Leyte, at Samar.
- 2. Isa lamang ang maaaring kumatawan sa bawat paaralan.
- 3. Ang paksa ay ibibigay sa mismong patimpalak. Ang paksa ay maaaring tungkol pero hindi limitado sa pulitika, sining, o isyung panlipunan.
- 4. Maaari lamang gamitin ang itim na pluma, at mga bond paper na may A4 na sukat.
- 5. Ang sanaysay ay hindi maaaring humigit sa 350 na salita at dapat nakasulat gamit ang itim na tinta
- Ang lahat ng kalahok ay dapat nakapasok sa Zoom na nakabukas ang camera. Kailangang nakatuon ang camera kung saan nagsusulat ang mga kalahok. Bibigyan ng sampung (10) minuto ang bawat isa upang i-set-up ang camera bago magsimula ang patimpalak.
- 7. Bibigyan ang lahat ng dalawang (2) oras para maisulat ang sanaysay, i-scan ang mga ito, at ipasa sa Google Forms submission bin na ibibgay ng facilitator.


POSTER-MAKING CONTEST

(ELEMENTARY and JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL)

- 1. The Poster-Making contest is open to all public and private primary and secondary schools in Biliran, Leyte and Samar.
- 2. Each school can send only one representative.
- There will be a short Zoom meeting at the beginning of the poster-making session to announce
 the topic and to signal the start of the competition. Contestants may opt to leave the said
 meeting afterwards.
- 4. Each contestant will be given two (2) hours to draw a poster/visual representation of the topic on a 1/8 illustration board. Drawing materials (pencil, eraser, marker, pen, pastels etc.) shall be provided by the participants, and these will be the only materials allowed during the competition.
- 5. Each contestant shall record themselves in a timelapse manner while creating the poster/visual representation. The recording will be submitted on a designated link and time. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- 6. The topic could range from politics to entertainment to the latest social issues to anything under the sun.
- 7. Use of text will be allowed but must be minimal.
- 8. The criteria for judging will be based on:

CONTENT 70%
Substance and Relevance 40%
Organization 30%
CREATIVITY OF CONCEPT 30%

- 9. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.
- 10. The winning contestants (1st, 2nd, and 3rd Places) and their respective coaches will be awarded medals and Certificates of Recognition. All participants will receive Certificates of Participation.
- 11. ALL participants are **required** to attend the **opening program** on the first day of the event. Failure to do so would lead to their **disqualification**.




EXTEMPORANEOUS SPEAKING CONTEST

(JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL ONLY)

- The Extemporaneous Speaking contest is open to all public and private secondary schools in Biliran, Leyte and Samar.
- Each school can send only one representative.
- Only the English language must be used throughout the delivery of the whole piece. All
 contestants will be given the same topic in the order of their turn, which shall be determined
 by drawing lots.
- 4. Contestants shall only wear business casual attire.
- 5. Each contestant will be given four minutes to prepare their piece. Afterwards, they shall enter the breakout rooms and wait for their turn.
- 6. The speech will be delivered in the main Zoom meeting. After entering, participants will be given 2 minutes to set up the camera and speakers, and 4 minutes to deliver their speech.
- 7. The criteria for judging will be based on:

- The winning contestant will be awarded medals and Certificates of Recognition. Their coaches will be given Certificates of Recognition. All participants will receive Certificates of Participation.
- 10. **ALL** participants are **required** to attend the **opening program** on the first day of the event. Failure to do so would lead to their **disqualification**.
