**DEPLOYMENT OF DIVISION ENGINEERS TO CONDUCT ASSESSMENT  
OF DAMAGES IN SOUTHERN LEYTE AND MAASIN CITY DIVISIONS**

To: Schools Division Superintendents  
All Others Concerned

1. This Office calls for the deployment of all Division Engineers to Maasin City and Southern Leyte Divisions on December 21-23, 2021, to help in the assessment of damages and subsequently, for the preparation of Program of Works for repair and rehabilitation of buildings damaged by Typhoon Odette.
2. Further, the Division Engineers are requested to include in the assessment those buildings which have already been reported for demolition.
3. In the interim, this Office likewise requests Schools Division Offices that are not affected much by Typhoon Odette to lend their power generator, if they have, to Southern Leyte and Maasin City.
4. The transportation and other incidental expenses of the engineers who are temporarily deployed to conduct assessment of damages in the typhoon-hit Divisions shall be charged to their respective MOOE subject to usual government rules and accounting procedures.
