Warm Greetings!

We would like to express our gratitude for your continued support and collaboration with the initiatives of the Sustaining Education Reform Gains (SERG) Project of the Australian Government through the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT) and Save the Children Philippines (SCP) with regards to advancing the professional development of teachers through the Learning and Development System.

For the third year of the SERG Project, we are happy to note that the health quarantine status due to the COVID-19 pandemic is generally loosening up. This will enable SERG to provide a visible presence in the provision of technical assistance to your Region and the SERG supported Schools Division Office (SDO) of Leyte and SDO of Baybay City. In view of the situation and the forthcoming activities of SERG to support the pilot of a school/division-level modalities for school heads/leaders learning and development (L&D) activities, we would like to request permission to begin blended face-to-face and virtual activities.

Specifically, we would like to request clearance and endorsement of the following major activities this coming January 2022:

- a. Technical Meetings with focal persons from the Regional CLMD, QAD, HRDD and Regional NEAP, SDO L&D Focal persons and SDO Coaches to discuss implementation updates and ways forward, especially with regards to the monitoring of the L&D initiatives. Dates for face-to-face meetings will be determined based on availability of the concerned regional and SDO personnel.
- b. 3-day Technical Workshop (face-to-face) to discuss and finalize the following: (Please see attached Program Schedule)
  - Guide to L&D Modalities for School Leaders. The objective is to develop an interschool L&D Modality among School Heads to support their continuous professional development.
  - 2. Finalize the Proposed Instructional Supervision (IS) Framework for Region VIII.

The focus on the pilot of modalities for school head's L&D and the instructional supervision are among two of the important outputs approved by the Project Steering Committee in the 12 October 2021 meeting.

- Four (4) from the Regional Office: 1 Chief/Representative each from CLMD, QAD, HRDD,
   Regional NEAP

Except for per diem, all expenses related to these activities (travel to and from the venue, billeting and meals) will be covered by the SERG Project.

### c. FGD with Pilot School Heads

A one hour FGD with the Pilot School Heads of the two SDOs respectively to discuss the role of Instructional Supervision in supporting the application of learning from the L&D Interventions implemented and promoting teacher professional development.

d. Monitoring of the pilot of the L&D System, including video documentation of school experiences, challenges, gains, and lessons learned as well as visit to the school.

The video documentation will form part of the materials for the forthcoming L&D Learning Exchange this coming March/April 2022. The video documentation will involve the interview with only 2 members of the School's L&D governing structure – i.e. Personnel Development Committee (PDC) and/or Project Management Team (PMT) of the following schools:
