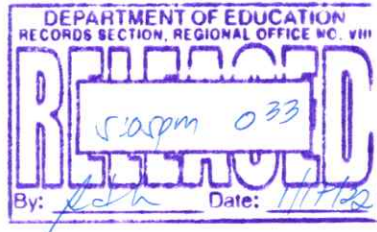

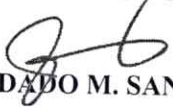

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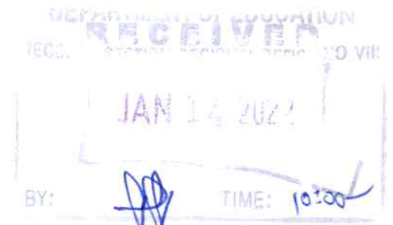

Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 071, s. 2021 titled, *Preparations for the Pilot Face-to-Face, Expansion, and Transitioning to the New Normal* and DepEd Memorandum No. 085, s. 2021 titled, *Preparations for the Implementation of the Expanded Phase of Face-to-Face Classes*, the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD), as the office mandated to support the field offices and schools in the delivery of basic education services for learners in different learning delivery modalities, will conduct an online orientation on the teaching-learning component of the implementation of the expanded phase of limited face-to-face classes on **January 18 – 20, 2022**.

Specifically, the orientation aims to:

- discuss the salient features of the JMC No. 1, s. 2021 relative to the teaching and learning delivery;
- ensure that there is logical continuity of the teaching-learning process in-school and off-school;
- emphasize the development of Learning Progress Checklist and other tools and types of formative assessments that are appropriate for limited F2F classes;
- address concerns and challenges on the part of field implementers on the conduct of the limited face-to-face classes.

Each region is expected to send **twelve (12) participants** composed of **CLMD and CID chiefs, select regional and division supervisors, school heads, and K to 12 teachers** who are part of the expanded implementation of face-to-face classes. Enclosed in Annex A is the Template of the List of Participants to be accomplished and submitted by the regional offices while Annex B contains the Indicative Program Matrix of this activity.
