Makatao at Maka-Pilipino: #JWDiokno Tiktok Competition

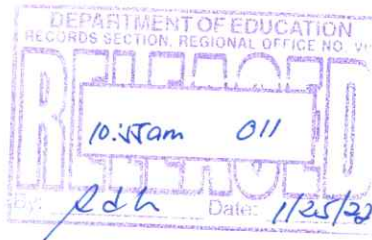


