

Meanwhile, to save expenses for the printing of the research report/paper, the Final/Initial Research Report/Manuscript based on Annex 6 of DO 16, s. 2017 shall be uploaded/submitted in electronic copy/PDF format through the link: https://bit.ly/3yz52Yo. Only the liquidation forms and attachments, separated from the Final/Initial Research Report/Manuscript, shall be submitted to the Regional Office. Another link shall be provided for the submission of the evaluated final paper required for the issuance of the Certificate of Completion.

The Schools Division Superintendents, through the Senior Education Program Specialists in Planning and Research and the Regional Functional Division Chiefs, for the Regional Office BERF beneficiaries, shall facilitate and ensure 100% compliance of the recipients.
