Pursuant to the Proclamation No. 771 (1996) declaring the third week of January as Autism Consciousness Week and in compliance with paragraph 3 of DM No. 022 s. 2021 entitled "Observance of National Celebrations on Advocacy Programs in Support of Inclusive Education" dated April 21, 2021, please be informed that the Autism Consciousness Week will be celebrated January 24 - 30, 2022 with the theme "Nurturing Public-Private Alliances Towards Autism-OK Philippines."

The observance aims to promote:

- 1. societal awareness on the uniqueness of Filipinos on the spectrum;
- 2. inclusive development in human rights, education, employment, media, among
- 3. individual self-awareness, self-expression and feeling of belonging to a compassionate society.

All National Government Agencies (NGAs), Local Government Units (LGUs), Non-Government Organizations (NGOs), organizations of persons with disabilities are enjoined to participate in the weeklong celebration through the following:

- a. hanging of advocacy streamers in conspicuous places of schools or offices. The layout design can be found in the enclosures may be downloaded from https://bit.ly/3FhUpNi and
- b. participation to activities organized by the Autism Society of the Philippines (activity schedules enclosed).

All public and private schools especially those with Special Education (SPED) Centers are encouraged to observe the 26th Autism Consciousness Week.
