



Dear RD Evelyn R. Fetalvero,

Warm Greetings!

Again, our gratitude for your support to SERG. In relation to the workshop and school visit originally targeted for January 10 to 14 but postponed because of the rising cases of COVID 19 in NCR and the other provinces, I write to request for a new date for the conduct of the "Workshop to Finalize a Guide to the Learning and Development (L&D) Modalities for School Leaders and the proposed Instructional Supervision Framework for Region VIII". We are requesting the date of the workshop to be on February 9 to 11, 2022.

As stated in our previous letter, the urgency for the workshop to be conducted as early as possible are for the following reasons:

- There are only 2 quarters left for the application of the Instructional Supervision (IS) Framework and the SERG Project. The IS Frame is meant to guide the school heads and education leaders to observe, reinforce and measure the application of the learned competencies of the teachers from start of SY 2021-22 based on the piloting of the L&D interventions designed through SERG and needing follow up to ensure application of learning by the Teachers of knowledge and skills gained.
- The Australian government through the Department of Foreign affairs and Trade (DFAT) is donating one tablet each to pilot schools. The tablet to be given to the principal's office in each of the pilot schools

- IS Framework, and
- Interschool L&D programs for school heads/leaders to be initiated by the SDO

The tablets had been procured and ready for distribution.

The urgency for the dates is also in consideration of the project closure by 14 October 2022. Hence, the intervention of the SERG Project will have to wrap-up around August 2022.

Please be assured that the conduct of the workshop will strictly follow the health protocols of the LGU and the IATF. Measures will include:

- The successive workshops will only include 10 participants, 4 representatives from the Region (CLMD, 1 from QAAD, HRD/Regional NEAP), and three each from SDO Leyte and SDO Baybay City (representative from CID, L&D Focal and Coach of the pilot schools)
- Maintain 20% participants in one venue (e.g. 12 individuals in a function that room for 50 pax)
- Only those who are fully vaccinated shall participate. Vehicle shall be provided to shuttle participants to avoid public transport. To maintain social distancing in the shuttle, a van good for 12 persons will only have 4 passengers
- An alternative to assigning transport, a point to point transportation of DepEd participants for the workshop will be reimbursed to enable them to rent vehicle instead of using public transport system
- For accommodation, participants' shall be assigned one room each.
- Masks, face shields and alcohol will be provided at all times.
- Avoid eating in one venue. Thus, meals will be packed so participants can eat in their own rooms or in any outdoor facility.

We will postpone the School Visit until such time as travel restrictions loosen up.

Our SERG Education Specialist assigned to your Region, Ms. Maya Lyn H. Banez, will be most happy to coordinate and discuss with your good office on further clarifications regarding the activities.
