PILOT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE HEALTHY LEARNING

INSTITUTIONS (HLI) FRAMEWORK

The Department of Education (DepEd) is a signatory to the Joint Administrative Order (JAO)1 on the Guidelines on Healthy Settings Framework in Learning Institutions, in line with Republic Act 11223 or the Universal Health Care (UHC) Act.2

Developed in coordination with Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), the Healthy Learning Institutions (HLI) Framework is planned to be eventually adopted as the framework for the Oplan Kalusugan sa DepEd (OK sa DepEd), the convergence of school health and nutrition programs and initiatives launched through DepEd Order No. 28, s. 2018.

For 2022, an integrated package of interventions shall be piloted in a maximum of 220 Last Mile Schools (LMSs) in select province-/city-wide health systems (P/CWHSs).3 The pilot implementation aims to set up and strengthen health systems within the Last Mile Schools, integrate these with local government counterparts, and develop a system of coordination between the health and education sectors to implement the HLI Framework, as mandated by the UHC Act.

While the local chief executives (LCEs) of the P/CWHSs will be the ones who shall submit to the Department of Health (DOH) their proposal or Letter of Intent to participate in the pilot implementation of the HLI Framework, DepEd schools and offices are expected to be involved in the necessary preparations for the said submission.

- 2. OK sa DepEd Coordinators are encouraged to coordinate directly with their respective counterparts in the DOH CHDs and in the LGUs before or after the scheduled orientation to discuss the details of the preparations and related activities.
- 3. SHN units, through their *OK* sa *DepEd* Coordinators and other concerned SHN personnel, are instructed to assist the identified LMSs in providing data that will be requested by the LCEs as part of the application requirements. The deadline for the submission of applications is 18 March 2022.

Once participating LMSs have been selected and announced by the DOH, the *OK sa DepEd* coordinators and other concerned SHN personnel of the ROs and SDOs of the said schools are expected to continue to provide necessary assistance in the activities expected of the schools through the various stages of the pilot implementation. These activities will be discussed in detail during the Orientation.
