**ON-SITE VALIDATION OF SCHOOL APPLICATIONS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS/LOCAL UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES /STATE UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES, MERGING, CONVERSION, SEPARATION OF PUBLIC SCHOOL ANNEXES AND RECOGNITION OF SPECIAL CURRICULAR PROGRAMS IN BASIC EDUCATION**

1. To intensify the remote validation process of the school applications conducted last October and November 2021 as emphasized in the Regional Memorandum No. 000611, s. 2021 re: **"Adoption and Implementation of Blended Validation Process (Remote and On-site) of School Applications for the Establishment of Public and Private Schools/LUCs/SUCs, Merging, Conversion, Separation of Public School Annexes and Recognition of Curricular Special Programs in Basic Education"** dated October 11, 2021, and in consideration of the findings and observations made during the remote validation process, this Office, through the Quality Assurance Division (QAD), announces the **Conduct of On-Site Validation of School Applications for the Establishment of Public and Private Schools/LUCs/SUCs, Merging, Conversion, Separation of Public School Annexes and Recognition of Special Curricular Programs in Basic Education** on January 24-28, 2022 and February 7-11, 2022.
2. The on-site validation process aims to:
  - 2.1 revalidate the non-compliance with the standards based on the findings and observations of the RIT/TWG during the remote process and
  - 2.2 provide sound recommendations for the accreditation, establishment and or recognition of schools.
