The Office of the Assistant Secretary for Alternative Learning System (ALS) through the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) will conduct the **16th National Consultative Conference for Regional ALS Focal Persons and other DepEd Officials** on March 21-25, 2022 (inclusive of travel time) in Region X, Bukidnon (*exact venue to be announced*).

The objective of the activity is to discuss the following:

- a. Operations/construction and inventory of Community Learning Centers (CLCs);
- b. Status of ALS programs and project implementation;
- c. Proposed conduct of ALS classes through limited face to face;
- d. Conduct of Presentation Portfolio Assessment Year 3;
- e. Implementation guidelines for ALS SHS; and
- f. ALS Manual of Operations.

In view of this, may we invite the Regional ALS Focal Persons and two (2) selected Division ALS Focal Persons to participate in the aforementioned activity. It is further requested that one of the participants who will attend from the field should be knowledgeable on the Community Learning Centers (CLCs) to provide input during the workshop on the operationalization/construction of CLCs.

Each region is requested to prepare a 10-15-minute presentation report highlighting the following:

- a. Status of ALS programs and projects implementation;
- b. SY 2021-2022 enrollment data;
- c. ALS SHS data; and
- d. ALS in SBM Data.

Please use the attached templates for the report.

Further, **Dr. Ray Butch Mahinay**, Regional ALS Focal Person of Region X, is also requested to assign at least two (2) documenters during the conference. They are expected to submit the minutes of the meeting to the BAE on March 31, 2022.

Transportation, board and lodging, and other expenses relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged against the 2022 ALS Continuing Funds. However, the **traveling expenses of participants shall be reimbursed to their respective regions** subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

The participants are also expected to comply with all **COVID-19 Alert Level System set by the national and local Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging and Infectious Diseases (IATF)**, as well as the most recent DepEd rules and/or polices.
