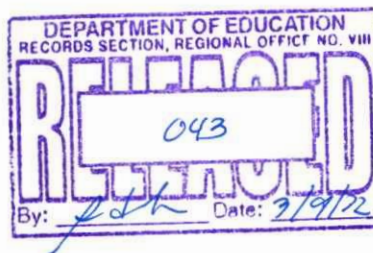

Greetings!

First of all, we would like to thank you for your unwavering support to our Lions Quest program.

As you know, we have already trained more than 34 "*Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao*" (EsP) teachers through our "Online Lions Quest Teachers Training Workshop" (TTW) last November 2020 and August 2021.

And in preparation for the eventual roll-out of the program in schools outside the NCR this school year, we would like to conduct one or two online TTW. Inasmuch as our expansion program will benefit 25,000 learners, we propose that we train more teachers on the Lions Quest program for them to gain access to our learning materials as well as certify them as Lions Quest teachers.

PROPOSED ONLINE LIONS QUEST "SKILLS FOR ADOLESCENCE" TTW WORKSHOP FORMAT

A. TWO (90 minute) ONLINE MODULES presented over TWO DAYS, namely:

1. Positive Classroom Learning Community/Social and Emotional Learning (SEL)
2. Lions Quest Curriculum Elements
3. Building Social and Emotional Competencies
4. Lions Quest Implementation

B. Proposed timing:

1. DAY 1: 10:00 Module 1 – 10:30 Break - 10:40 Module 2 - 11:30 Close
2. DAY 2: 10:00 Module 3 – 10:30 Break - 10:40 Module 4 - 11:30 Close

C. Logistics:

1. The online module will be available on February 28
2. The training workshop will be presented by Lions Quest Trainer Mr. Roland Julius Japone.
2. The training will be via ZOOM platform

D. Dates and Participating Schools:

1. The online training dates shall be in **March 5 & 12 or March 12 & 19, 2022.**
2. The participating schools shall be those appearing in the Memorandum of Agreement between the Department of Education and MD 301 Lions Quest and the schools who participated in the second TTW last August 2021.


E. Maximum number of participants – 20
