The activity focuses on teachers' rights and responsibilities as citizens and their roles in the electoral process.

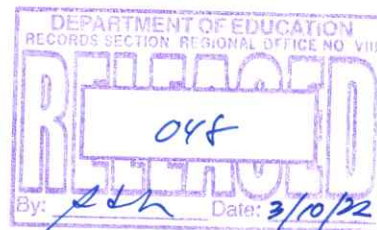

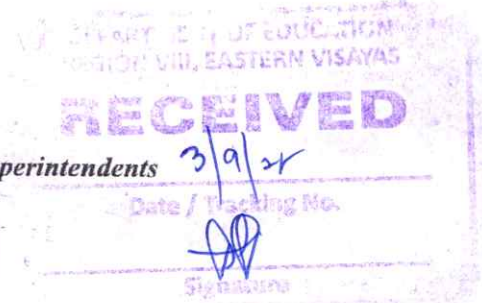

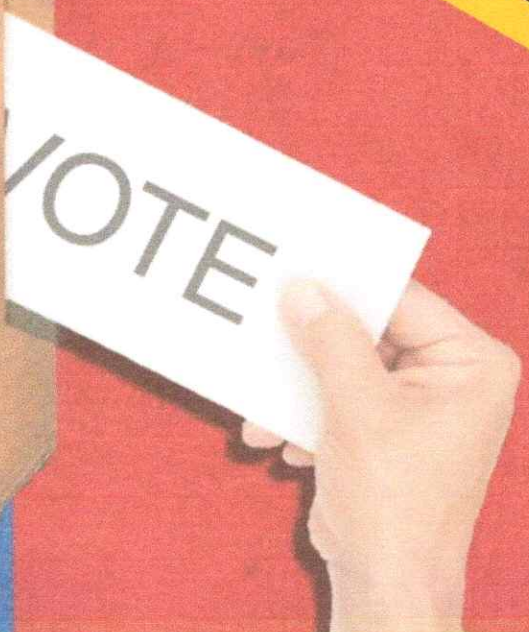
