CORRIGENDUM ON REGIONAL MEMORANDUM NO. 141, S. 2022

1. The first paragraph of Regional Memorandum No. 141, s. 2022 dated February 22, 2022 shall be read as:

"1. This Office, through the Administrative Division, shall conduct the 1st Quarter Convergence Meeting of Regional, Schools Division Offices and Implementing Units' Administrative Officials on March 23-24, 2022. The venue shall be at Baybay City Convention Center, Baybay City."

2. It is reiterated that RO and SDO participants' board and lodging are charged to RO downloaded funds to Baybay City Division. While the participants representing the Implementing Unit (IU) secondary schools shall pay a registration of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) as counterpart to defray expenses for the food provision exclusive of lodging/accommodation, payable to the host division.

3. The participants are expected to be at the venue in the morning of March 23, 2022. The first meal is served during the morning snacks and the last is served during the afternoon snacks on March 24, 2022.

4. The Regional Participants shall report to the venue on March 22, 2022 and shall leave on March 26, 2022.

5. Confirmed participants as manifested in the letter of intent received by this Office on or before March 10, 2022 are the Official Participants who are all considered attendees and subject to registration fee collection. In compliance with health and safety protocols against covid-19, everyone is enjoined to bring the necessary documentary requirements mandated by the local IATF.

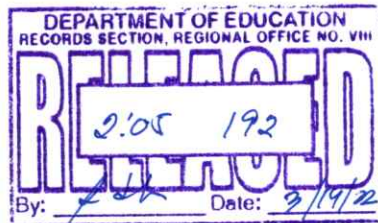


6. All other provisions of Regional Memorandum No. 141, s. 2022 shall remain in effect.
