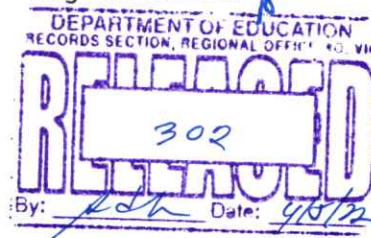

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

Date : March 31, 2022

The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE), conducted the 1st phase of the Development of Assessment Package for Alternative Learning System (ALS) Junior High School (JHS) Level in October and November 2021, participated by select ALS implementors. The said assessment package will be used by the ALS teachers as formative and summative assessment tools.

21 of the newly developed work samples were validated last December 21, 2021 in Regions IVA, VI and XI.

To continue the development process, a **Writershop on the Revision of the Validated Assessment Package for Junior High School Level** will be conducted on **April 18-23, 2022 (inclusive of travel time)**, in **Aurora, Region III**. The specific venue will be announced at a later date. The same participants in the previous activities conducted will be involved (*see Attachment No. 1*). ALS Teachers who will be participant to this activity shall conduct make-up classes upon return to their respective stations.

The first meal to be served will be AM snack of April 18, 2022, while the last meal will be breakfast of April 23, 2022.

Traveling expenses of the participants will be reimbursed to their respective Divisions chargeable against the 2022 FLO ALS Continuing Funds subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
