REGIONAL ARTS CONTESTS

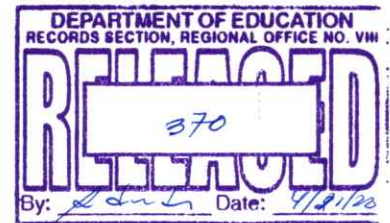

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum, DM-OUCI-2022-124, dated April 7, 2022 re: **3rd National Arts Contest**, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), shall conduct a **Regional Arts Contest** with the theme **"Dakilang Lahi"** on April 26, 2022.
2. The activity aims to showcase the talents in painting of elementary learners as they reflect the depth of their knowledge and understanding of the diplomatic relations between Philippines and Japan through their artwork.
3. The details on the schedule and mechanics of the said regional contest are as follows:
 - a. The Regional Arts Contest with the theme **"Dakilang Lahi"**, shall be held on April 26, 2022.
 - b. The contest is open to elementary learners and there shall be only one (1) entry for each division.
 - c. All entries/paintings shall be original on a canvas with 24 X 36 inches frame, using only acrylic or oil paint.
 - d. All entries for the whole duration of the actual painting shall be recorded and shall be emailed at clmd.region8@deped.gov.ph and novajorge@deped.gov.ph on or before April 25, 2022.
 - e. The division entries shall indicate the following information in their recorded video output:
 - a. Title of the Painting
 - b. Full Name, Age, Grade Level, School, Division, and Address of the Artist
 - c. Brief Description of the Painting in Tagalog or English
 - f. The top three (3) winners shall represent DepEd Region VIII to the 3rd National Arts Contests which shall be held on May 2022.
 - g. All regional entries will be exhibited at the Lupang Pangako Elementary School in Quezon City and shall be considered the sole property of the sponsor.



- h. The SDOs with the winning entries shall be in-charged in sending the paintings to the address stipulated below:

 - i. Expenses incurred relative to the said contest including the shipping of the winning entries shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
 - j. All regional winners will receive Certificate of Recognition while the non-winners including the school will be given Certificate of Participation.
 - k. The criteria for judging are as follows:
35%- Relevance to the theme;
30%- Originality;
25%- Creativity and presentation; and
10%- Over-all impact

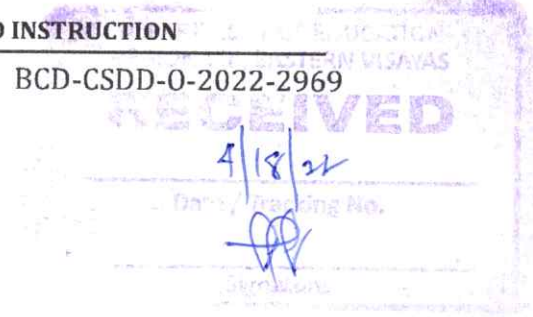


