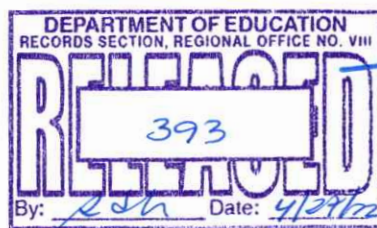

DOWNLOADING OF FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE MONITORING AND EVALUATION ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SPECIAL EDUCATION (SPED) PROGRAM IN THE REGION AND CONVERSION OF THE IDENTIFIED SPED CENTER INTO AN INCLUSIVE LEARNING RESOURCE CENTER (ILRC) IN THE DIVISION OF ORMOC CITY

1. To facilitate the smooth conduct of the Monitoring and Evaluation on the Implementation of the Special Education (SPED) Program and Conversion of SPED Centers into Inclusive Learning Resource Centers (ILRCs) on May 16-20, 2022, stipulated in DM-CI-2022-00072 dated March 4, 2022, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division, (CLMD), shall download an amount of **one hundred thirty-five thousand pesos (Php 135,000.00)** to the Schools Division of Ormoc City.
2. The said amount shall be taken from the remainder of the Regional Office Special Education (SPED) Program Support Funds per SARO No. OSEC-8-21-3568 and shall be used to cover expenses on board and lodging, rental of venue, equipment, and/or facilities, travel allowance, transportation, and other related expenses subject to the existing auditing and accounting rules and regulations.
3. A separate memorandum specifying other details on this activity shall also be issued.
4. The Schools Division of Ormoc City is requested to expedite the processing of the related documents and submit a utilization report to the CLMD two weeks after the culmination of the activity.
5. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.

DATE : March 4, 2022

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) through the Bureau of Learning Delivery-Student Inclusion Division (BLD-SID) will conduct the Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) on the Implementation of the Special Education (SPED) Program and Conversion of the SPED Centers into Inclusive Learning Resource Centers (ILRCs) on March to May, 2022, in all regions for the School Year 2021-2022.
2. The M&E activity shall be conducted to gather data on the implementation of Inclusive Education in SPED during the pandemic and to track the progress of conversion of the SPED Centers into ILRCs. Specifically, the BLD-SID M&E Team aims to:
 - gather data on the implementation of SPED program during the pandemic;
 - assess the effectiveness and efficiency of the field implementers in implementing policies, programs and projects towards the realization of SPED targets and DepEd standards during the pandemic;
 - recognize issues and concerns for appropriate interventions and/or technical assistance.



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- evaluate the progress of conversion of the SPED Center classrooms into support service areas of an ILRCs if it is compliant with the design and layout prescribed;
3. All concerned are directed to accomplish the M&E Tools. The tools which include a) ILRC Questionnaire and b) Questionnaire for School Head shall be uploaded in the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) starting March 14, 2022. The SDOs shall be given fifteen (15) days to accomplish the tools and shall be submitted to the BLD-SID through email at bld.sid@deped.gov.ph on or before April 4, 2022.
 4. The M&E through the Regional SPED Focal Persons shall be conducted in all regions simultaneously.
