
The participants are the junior and senior high school learners who are enthusiasts of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM).








- 1. The contest shall have two (2) rounds: Preliminary Round and Final Round. The Preliminary Round is for all the successful registered participants. Only the top half of the total participants will participate in the Final Round. The Preliminary Round will be on June 1, 2022 at 6 pm. and the Final Round will be on June 4, 2022 at 1 pm.
- 2. The quiz bee (both Preliminary and Final Round) has three levels: EASY, AVERAGE, and DIFFICULT.
- 3.Questions will come from the following areas: Algebra, Geometry, Statistics, Analytical Geometry, Trigonometry, Calculus, Chemistry, and Physics.
- 4. Edmodo shall be used for answering questions in both the preliminary and final rounds. Zoom Meeting will be used simultaneously in the Final Round, and participants must enter the meeting 30 minutes before the scheduled time to ascertain that only the contestant answers the questions.
- 5.Participants will have to use either a desktop or laptop (the use of mobile phones is discouraged as the questions may be displayed erroneously). Participants must have their own internet or data connection and must have their camera and microphone open throughout the quiz bee.
- 6. Each participant must have a paper, pen, and calculator for solving.
- 7. Each participant will start with a zero score at the start of Easy Level. The Final Score for the Final Ranking will be based on the accumulation of points throughout the quiz bee (Preliminary plus the Final Round scores).
- 8. All participants will have to wait for the signal from the Quiz Master before answering the questions.
- 9.Questions and protests from participants regarding the answer to the items will be entertained before the start of the next level. If a protest shall arise, the participants may raise their complaints to the Quiz Master and will be forwarded to the Board of Judges. The decision of the Board of Judges is always final.
- IQ. In case of a tie for the top 8 places, the tie will be broken through their score in Preliminary Round. The one who got the higher score will get the higher place. If they are still tied in the scores for the Preliminary Round, then the tie will be broken by the score in Final Round. If still, the tie is not broken, then a do-or-die question will be given. The first contestant who raises the correct answer to the board of judges will be carefulated the winner. The do-or-die question is not a multiple-choice question.
