The activity aims to share insights on leadership and human resource management and help agencies realign their own practices with the emerging global challenges and trends in the same.

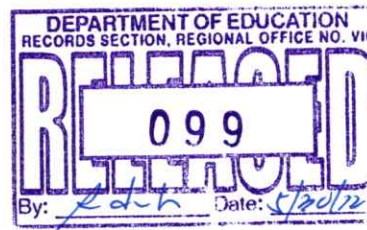
